


ALCOHOL TEST #2

The following test can be performed to determine the presence of alcohol in gasoline, 1, On a test tube or vial make a permanent line about two inches from the bottom. 2. Fill with water to the line, then fill the tube to the top with gasoline. 3. Cover the tube, agitate it then let it stand.

Alcohol mixes with water and the two will separate out together. Therefore, if after mixing the water and the fuel, the water level appears to increase, then the fuel contains alcohol and should not be used.

Less than 5% ethanol will sometimes be indicated by a slight decrease in the water level. Therefore any deviation in the water line should be viewed as a basis for rejecting the fuel.

Alcohol increases the volatility of fuel, and hence the possibility of vapor lock also increases.






"The latest news on Human Waste

Management"

Excerpt from an early 1995 issue of the "Rapids"

"For years, boaters have been carrying out the human waste from their trips on many western rivers. Even before regulations requiring carry out, environmentally conscious boaters believed this was the "right thing to do" to protect the land adjacent to popular rivers. We found it easy to line rocket boxes with plastic bags to contain the waste which would later be thrown away with other garbage generated by the trip. On protected rivers, managing agencies provided "honey wagons" at take-outs where the bags of waste could be deposited and transported to landfills."

I am inserting this to remind everyone - this is a regulations in Hells Canyon. The 4th of July we were in the canyon and stopped at Cottonwood to rest. I was appalled at the condition of the campsite. We need to be good stewards of this area we all love so much.
