Bob Hays reported that he, Bill Davis, Rich Vaughn, and Shay White met with Sandra Mitchell and Rob Thornberry from the Theodore Roosevelt Foundation Collaborative (voices on all users) to discuss the Salmon Valley Stewardship Collaborative. They will be meeting with Representative Moon from Salmon on Thursday. There is no jet boat representation on the collaborative. Bob will be going to Salmon to meet with them on February 21, 2018. We will be requesting access to their document and plans.

BBQ Committee is working on the pump boxes and switches. They will fix-up the trailer after Glenns Ferry Run. Should be beautiful when finished.

Chili Run was discussed: Pre-run Saturday at Walter's Ferry at 9:00 a.m. Clean-up at Rattlesnake Beach. Please bring some rakes and shovels....the water is very high. The main run will be on Sunday at 10:00 a.m. from Walter's Ferry to Rattlesnake. Bring your best recipes.

Guest Speaker David Dahms from Idaho Parks and Recreation gave a short update. No new legislation this year. Grants available are both the Waterways and RV/Campground. The approval

process starts in March thru May and Hells Canyon Recreation Colloborative would receive their grant money by July 1st if chosen. Committee member are chosen from a large group of users and as soon as the grants are awarded it will be posted on Facebook for the community.
