It is being reported that the road to Pittsburg Landing is extremely icy at this time. If you plan to travel over Pittsburg Saddle in the next few weeks, please be equipped with chains and be prepared to use them.

On January 6th, 2020 the repairs will start on the Salmon River bridge. This is the bridge you have to cross once you leave Hwy 95, to access the road to Pittsburg Landing and the Hammer Creek Recreation area. The bridge will be closed from 7 am to 10am, then open for travel between 10 and 11, then closed again from 11 to 2pm. All times are Pacific standard time. All boaters who operate a motorboat over 10 horsepower (hp) and youths 12-15 operating a motorboat of any size are required to take an approved boating safety course and apply/carry a boater education card.

Non-Oregon residents will need to either obtain an Oregon Boater Education Card or have a card from any state that issues cards for NASBLA-approved courses.


