## Oregon Boater **Education Card**

All boaters who operate a motorboat over 10 horsepower (hp) and youths 12-15 operating a motorboat of any size are required to take an approved boating safety course and apply/carry a boater education card.

Non-Oregon residents will need to either obtain an Oregon Boater Education Card or have a card from any state that issues cards for NASBLA-approved courses.

### Snake River

In order to slow the spread of COVID-19, we are working to align our Forest operations with executive orders in the states of Oregon, Washington, and Idaho. Many of our neighboring Idaho forests have already responded in a similar fashion by issuing closure orders for recreation sites. The Wallowa-Whitman will be issuing a closure order in the next day or so. It will include recreation sites in the Hells Canyon NRA in its entirety, not the Oregon side vs. Idaho side. The purpose of the closure is to limit group sizes at all our recreation sites and discourage non-essential travel to the Forest for recreation purposes.

While we will be closing recreation sites (i.e. visitor centers, campgrounds, trailheads, boat ramps, etc.), we are not closing the Forest or the Snake River. If use of Forest boat ramps is necessary for canyon or local residents for travel to work, purchasing groceries and essential supplies, health care, etc., then use of boat ramps would be in compliance with State orders regarding essential travel.

Commercial use of boat ramps is something we are considering more carefully. Outfitter boards in both Idaho and Oregon have explained the State orders, but are leaving compliance with orders, and the decision to operate up to the outfitter. We are encouraging outfitters and guides to adhere to the terms of their special use permit by complying with state and local health authority requirements. Again, focusing on group size.

The Forest is encouraging residents to stay home, stay safe, and save lives. As you know, this is bigger than all of us. It is not just about the needs of the individual, but the needs of their family, and their community. We'll be here ready for them when it's much safer for all of us.



### Planning to Boat in Oregon this year?

Please note that the state of Oregon has modified their boating laws starting January 1, 2020. Visiting boaters are no longer exempted from the requirement to have boating education. All boaters, regardless of residency, must demonstrate proof that they have completed a boating safety course.

Oregon will accept the Idaho boating course and card. We offer three ways to get an Idaho boating safety card:

- 1) Home study course (study course materials at your own pace for free). Call Dave Dahms at 208-514-2412 or email david.dahms@idpr.idaho.gov to request a free course book.
- 2) On-line courses. The state of Idaho has approved four on-line vendors. Some vendors charge a fee (\$30-\$35), but the Boat U.S. Foundation course is free.
- 3) IDPR can work with WWA to schedule a class for those interested. Classes run approximately 6 hours and can be done in one day or spread over two days.

All three options require the passing of an exam to get the boating safety card. For more details on Idaho boating education options visit www.boatidaho.gov
