Winter Boating Tips

If you are in and out of the water without drying the pump bowl out, check the weep hole in the bottom of the pump bowl to make sure it has not become plugged with debris. If you try to start your engine when the impellor is encased with ice it will most likely mess up the pump, impellor. If you place the boat into the water and let stand a while, the ice will thaw out and you will be ready to go.

Check the trailer tire pressures to make sure they are up to the proper air pressure. Many trips are hampered by tire problems and usually caused by a tire getting over temperature due to low tire pressures.

We will have more information on trailer tires prior to the summer.

Planning to Boat in Oregon this year?

Please note that the state of Oregon modified their boating laws in 2020. Visiting boaters are no longer exempted from the requirement to have boating education. All boaters, regardless of residency, must demonstrate proof that they have completed a boating safety course.

Oregon will accept the Idaho boating course and boater education card. Idaho Department of Parks & Recreation offers three ways to get a card:

- 1) Home study course study the course materials at your own pace for free. Call David Dahms at (208) 514-2412 or email david.dahms@idpr.idaho.gov to request a free course book.
- 2) On-line courses. The state of Idaho has approved four on-line vendors. Some vendors charge a fee ranging from \$30-\$40, but the Boat U.S. Foundation course is free.
- 3) In-person class. Idaho Parks & Rec and local marine deputies around the state offer free classes on occasion. The classes run approximately 6 hours and a current listing can be found at www.boatidaho.gov. Note class availability is extremely limited at this time due to Covid-19. All three options require the passing of an exam to get the boating safety card.


