Spring Chinook Salmon Fishing Update

The fish are working their way up the river system with the bulk of the run anticipated over the Bonneville Dam in the next two weeks. The run is just getting to Lower Granite on the Snake River but numbers there indicate that the run is stronger than last year. While there is no report of harvest on the Salmon River at the time of this report the Rapid River Hatchery has reported that two adult salmon have reached the hatchery and indicates that the fish are in the river system. First report of harvest in Idaho is anticipated within the week.

Please note that the season is restricted to four days per week in designated areas of the river system, check the rules before you pull your boat to the river. 




