




Report on Salmon Challis National Forest

Plan Revision By Bob Hays On November 23, 2021 Josh Milligan, Plan Revision Team Leader for the Salmon Challis National Forest (SCNF) confirmed that the forest is still operating under two plans that were put in place in the late 1980's for the then Salmon National Forest and Challis National Forest which were consolidated into the SCNF in 1998. While the original plans have been revised multiple times, in 2017 an effort to develop one current plan for the SCNF was initiated. WWA representatives participated on the Salmon Valley Stewardship Collaborative in providing a user based comment process to this effort. After much feed-back, from various quarters, that effort was tabled in 2019/2020 when it became apparent, the "resource use" based Challis National Forest plan/area, did not fit well with a "wilderness based" Salmon National Forest plan. The process going forward calls for the revision/development of two plans, one for each area. An internal USFS staff meeting is planned for the first of 2022 and to move slowly as the new plans are developed. Bob's Note -Much work, public comment and time was invested into the Wild and Scenic Rivers (WSR) and wilderness portions of the shelved plans, hopefully this work will not be dismissed. Note the WSR & Wilderness Recommendations are required in the 2012 Planning Rule. Josh Milligan can be reached at 208-756-5560 and plan progress is noted on the SCNF Web site

- Counts include wild and hatchery origin fish. Most steelhead bound for Idaho cross Bonneville Dam between July 1 and October 31.
- Information on numbers of steelhead crossing the Columbia and Snake River dams is taken from data posted by the United States Army Corps of Engineers, and is updated weekly during the counting season.
